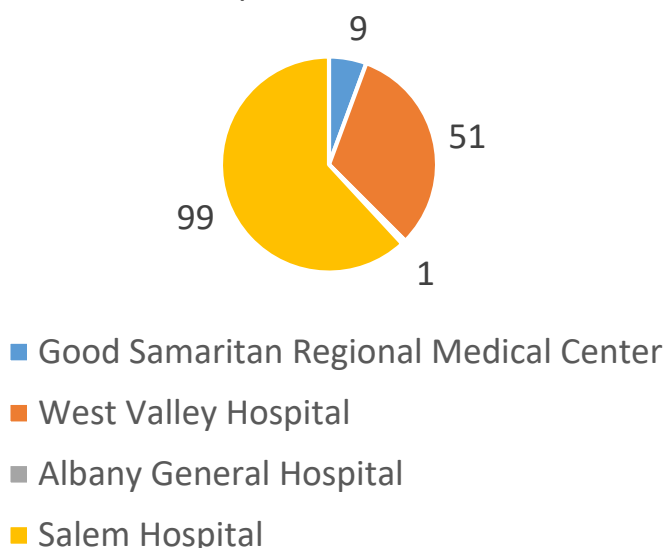
## Apparatus Updates
